



CLUES

1. Locate a square shape.
2. Find something that starts with the letter "A".
3. Locate two objects that are in the shape of a circle.
4. Find three items that are the color blue.
5. Locate a yellow object and count how many sides it has.
6. Find an object that starts with the letter "C".
7. Locate two objects that are in the shape of a triangle.
8. Find three items that are the color yellow.
9. Locate two objects that start with the letter "D".
10. Find three things that are in the shape of a rectangle.
11. Locate an orange object and count how many corners it has.
12. Locate a blue object and count how many straight sides it has.
13. Find five things that are the same color.

Scavenger Hunt Instructions

1. Give your child a numbered map and a list of clues labeled 1-13.
2. Explain that their task is to find and mark off each number 1-13 on the map as they discover the corresponding clue from the list.
3. Encourage them to read each clue carefully and think about where it might lead them within the house.
4. Let them know that each clue will guide them closer to the treasure, which could be a small prize or a fun activity at the end.
5. Once they locate a clue, have them mark off the corresponding number on the map to keep track of their progress.
6. If working with siblings remind them to work together and help each other out if needed.
7. Once they reach clue 13 and mark it off on the map, they will have successfully completed the scavenger hunt and should be close to the treasure.
8. Celebrate their accomplishment and let them enjoy the surprise or reward awaiting them at the final treasure location.
